This one-credit embedded course in Georgia provides a one-week immersion in Georgian culture combined with lectures on Georgian history and contemporary politics, including the long history of Georgian-Russian love-hate relations. The program includes a tour of the Georgian capital, Tbilisi, and its surroundings; key museums and monasteries, interaction with local students, a cooking class, calligraphy workshop, day trips to Kakheti and Kazbegi, a visit to a Georgian sulfur bath, and more!

This program is open to students taking any Russian course in the spring 2024 semester (RUS 2, RUS 100, RUS 142, RUS 200, RUS 403, RUS 420). Students participating in the embedded program will be manually enrolled in a 1-credit travel course, RUS 197.
